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
EXCITING NEW COMPETITIONS

She was very brave and she did suffer a terrible injury from an attack. She now lives in England and has won the Nobel Peace Prize. This summer she graduated from Oxford University!

THE STORY: As a child in Pakistan Malala wished for a magic pencil with which she could redraw reality. She wanted a magic pencil so she could use it to give good things to others and herself. As she got older, she wished for bigger and bigger things as she realised how much in the world needed fixing and how many things in the world were unfair.
